

PTA After-School Enrichment Program Instructions

Registration is now open for Cherokee PTA's after school enrichment program. Please see attached information for class offerings and descriptions. Participation in these programs will enrich your child and contribute to PTA. Each program offered gives a percentage of class tuition to PTA.

Below are several important things for you to know:

- These programs are NOT Lakota sponsored activities.
- There is no limit to the number of classes that your child may choose to participate in as long as class times/dates don't conflict.
- **Payment** amount varies by class. See each class description for payment information.
- **Dates and times vary by class.** See each class description for information specific to your class.
- If school is cancelled, class is cancelled. In the event there is an early release, after school classes will be cancelled and all children sent home via their normal method.
- Please note the pickup time for your child. It is your responsibility to pick your child up on time from class. If your child is picked up late, they may be removed from the class at their instructor's discretion. Refunds will not be given.
- There is a minimum and maximum number of students allowed in each class. If a minimum number of children do not register for a particular class, the class will be cancelled.
- Each after school program may have their own registration dates that differ from the PTA deadline. Cherokee PTA paper registration forms must be received by the PTA no later than **Wednesday, October 9**. Online dates may vary based on enrollment and instructor preference.
- **Complete the Cherokee PTA registration and emergency medical authorization (EMA) form** and return to school in an envelope marked: PTA After-School Program. **Students will not be allowed to attend classes until the EMA form is received. NO refunds will be given for classes missed due to PTA not receiving a student's EMA form. If you register online, you do not need to turn in a paper form.**
- You will be notified at least two days prior to class via email that your registration is confirmed. If you do not receive an e-mail, your paperwork was not received and you are not registered. You should contact Jennifer Brueshaber at CEafterschoolprogram@gmail.com or 755-8200 x16217.
- Programs offered will vary each session. There may be an increase or decrease in programs offered as attendance dictates. The PTA welcomes new ideas for programs and encourages you to share your ideas.
